- 6 stock, for more than ten minutes at a time, any public highway,
- 7 street, or alley in any unincorporated town or village in the
- 8 State of Nebraska. Any corporation, person, or firm or individual
- 9 violating any provision of this section shall, upon conviction
- 10 thereof, be fined in any sum not less than ten dollars nor more
- 11 than one hundred dollars. guilty of a Class I misdemeanor and shall
- 12 <u>be fined one thousand dollars for each offense.</u>
