A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to schools; to state findings; to annul certain
- 2 orders as prescribed; and to declare an emergency.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. The Legislature finds that when the people of
2 Nebraska voted to repeal Laws 2005, LB 126, it was the voters'
3 intention to nullify the actions of the State Committee for the
4 Reorganization of School Districts which dissolved Class I and
5 Class VI school districts so that those districts could continue to
6 educate the school children of Nebraska as they had in the past.

7 Sec. 2. The Legislature further finds that it has the
8 plenary authority to create, reorganize, and dissolve school
9 districts, the plenary authority to create, dissolve, or amend
10 the legal authority of the State Committee for the Reorganization
11 of School Districts, and the plenary authority to legislatively
12 overrule such committee's decisions and orders regarding the
13 reorganization of school districts.

14 Sec. 3. All of the orders issued by the State Committee
15 for the Reorganization of School Districts pursuant to Laws 2005,
16 LB 126, dissolving Class I and Class VI school districts, attaching
17 their territory to other school districts, and transferring school
18 districts' assets, and any and all related orders, are hereby
19 rescinded, revoked, and annulled, and for all legal purposes, all
20 of those orders shall be deemed to have never been issued.

21 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
22 when passed and approved according to law.
