Section 1. Section 14-117, Revised Statutes Cumulative
 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:

3 14-117 The corporate limits of any city of the metropolitan class shall be fixed and determined by ordinance by 4 the council of such city. The city council of any city of the 5 6 metropolitan class may at any time extend the corporate limits of 7 such city over any contiguous or adjacent lands, lots, tracts, 8 streets, or highways, such distance as may be deemed proper in any direction, and may include, annex, merge, or consolidate with such 9 10 city of the metropolitan class, by such extension of its limits, 11 any adjoining city of the first class having less than ten thousand 12 population or any adjoining city of the second class or village. 13 The extension of the corporate limits may extend into an adjoining county. Any other laws and limitations defining the boundaries 14 of cities or villages or the increase of area or extension of 15 16 limits thereof shall not apply to lots, lands, cities, or villages 17 annexed, consolidated, or merged under this section.
