A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to all-terrain vehicles; to amend section
2 60-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2006; to
3 provide requirements for applying for certificates of title;
4 to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original section.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative
2 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:

3 60-101. Sections 60-101 to 60-197 and section 2 of this act
4 shall be known and may be cited as the Motor Vehicle Certificate of
5 Title Act.

6 Sec. 2. An application for a certificate of title for an
7 all-terrain vehicle shall be accompanied by a certificate that states
8 that sales or use tax has been paid on the purchase of the
9 all-terrain vehicle or that the transfer of title was exempt from
10 sales and use taxes. The county clerk or designated county official
11 shall issue a certificate of title for an all-terrain vehicle but
12 shall not deliver the certificate of title unless the certificate
13 required under this section accompanies the application for
14 certificate of title for the all-terrain vehicle, except that the
15 failure of the application to be accompanied by such certificate
16 shall not prevent the notation of a lien on the certificate of title
17 to the all-terrain vehicle pursuant to section 60-164 and delivery to
18 the holder of the first lien.

19 Sec. 3. Original section 60-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative
20 Supplement, 2006, is repealed.
