FOR AN ACT relating to labor; to require an employer to provide

employee a reason for termination as prescribed; and to

provide a duty for the Revisor of Statutes.

4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. (1) No employee of an employer, as defined in 2 section 48-801, or nonexempt employee under the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, 29 U.S.C. 201 et seg., shall be terminated from 3 employment until such employee has been given the specific reason for 4 5 the proposed termination and the employee is provided a meaningful opportunity to present the employee's position in response to the 6 7 reason for the proposed termination. (2) This section shall be construed as providing a minimum 8 9 standard and not as repealing or negating any collective bargaining agreement or any provision of law specifically setting forth the 10 11 rights of a particular group or groups of employees. Sec. 2. The Revisor of Statutes shall assign section 1 of 12 this act to Chapter 48, article 2. 13
