**LEGISLATIVE BILL 198**

A BILL

1       FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Political Accountability and  
2               Disclosure Act; to amend section 49-1474.02, Revised  
3               Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2006; to change requirements  
4               for campaign messages; and to repeal the original section.  
5       Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. Section 49-1474.02, Revised Statutes Cumulative  
2 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:

3           49-1474.02. (1) Any person who makes an expenditure  
4 reportable under the Nebraska Political Accountability and Disclosure  
5 Act to disseminate by any means of telecommunication a prerecorded  
6 message or a recorded message relating to a candidate or ballot  
7 question shall include, immediately preceding the message, in the  
8 message the name of the person, ~~including committees,~~ making the  
9 expenditure. Such messages shall only be disseminated between the  
10 hours of 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. at the location of the person  
11 receiving such messages. Only one such message shall be disseminated  
12 to any one residential telephone line per calendar day.

13           (2) Any person who makes an expenditure reportable under the  
14 act to disseminate by any means of telecommunication a message  
15 relating to a candidate or ballot question which is not a recorded  
16 message or a prerecorded message shall, immediately upon the request  
17 of the recipient of the message, disclose the name of the person,  
18 including committees, making the expenditure. If the message is  
19 disseminated through an employee or agent of the person making the  
20 expenditure, the employee or agent shall, immediately upon the request  
21 of the recipient of the message, disclose the name of the person,  
22 including committees, making the expenditure.

23           (3) Any person who makes an expenditure reportable under the  
24 act to disseminate by any electronic means, including the Internet or  
25 email, a message relating to a candidate or ballot question shall  
26 include in the message the name of the person, including committees,  
27 making the expenditure.
