A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Integrated Solid Waste Management Act;
2 to amend section 13-2001, Revised Statutes Cumulative
3 Supplement, 2006; to define a term; to prohibit certain
4 liens; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original
5 section.

6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 13-2001, Revised Statutes Cumulative
2 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:

3 13-2001. Sections 13-2001 to 13-2043 and section 2 of this
4 act shall be known and may be cited as the Integrated Solid Waste
5 Management Act.

6 Sec. 2. (1) For purposes of this section, elected official
7 means a mayor or a member of a city council, village board of
8 trustees, or county board.

9 (2) Beginning January 1, 2008, a joint entity or joint
10 public agency created pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act or
11 the Joint Public Agency Act that provides services under the
12 Integrated Solid Waste Management Act shall not place a lien on
13 property for nonpayment of debt unless the agreement creating the
14 joint entity or joint public agency provides or is modified to
15 provide for a governing board that consists of elected officials.

17 Cumulative Supplement, 2006, is repealed.
