A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Commission of Industrial Relations; to
2 amend section 48-806, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska;
3 to change the judges' compensation; and to repeal the
4 original section.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 48-806, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 48-806. As soon as ~~such compensation~~ the same may be
4 legally paid under the Constitution of Nebraska, ~~the compensation of~~
5 ~~judges~~ each judge of the Commission of Industrial Relations shall
6 be ~~two hundred fifty dollars~~ paid per day for each day's time
7 actually engaged in the performance of the duties of their office.
8 The per diem rate shall be the daily equivalent of a district judge's
9 annual salary under section 24-301.01. Each judge shall also be paid
10 his or her necessary traveling expenses incurred while away from his
11 or her place of residence upon business of the commission in
12 accordance with sections 81-1174 to 81-1177.
