1	Section 1. Notwithstanding any order made by the State
2	Committee for the Reorganization of School Districts, by any court,
3	or by any other body and notwithstanding any statutory provision
4	to the contrary, every school district which existed on November
5	30, 2005, but was later dissolved, is hereby reestablished and duly
6	constituted with the same boundaries, assets, liabilities, school
7	board members, and legal powers and financial authority, including
8	budget authority and any funds attributable thereto, which such
9	district possessed on November 30, 2005, and with any additional
10	assets which such district would have subsequently possessed if it
11	had not been dissolved. Any school district, public official, or
12	person in possession or control, physical or legal, of any assets
13	which on June 14, 2006, were the property of any school district
14	which was dissolved after November 30, 2005, and is reestablished
15	by this section or any assets which would have become the property
16	of the dissolved school district after June 14, 2006, if the school
17	district had not been dissolved, shall immediately convey those
18	assets to the reestablished school district.
19	Sec. 2. The Revisor of Statutes shall assign section 1 of
20	this act to Chapter 79, article 4.

21 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect 22 when passed and approved according to law.
