A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to parking permits; to amend section 18-1740,
2 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2006; to change
3 provisions relating to permanently issued permits for
4 handicapped or disabled parking; and to repeal the
5 original section.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 18-1740, Revised Statutes Cumulative
2 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:

3 18-1740 ~~(1)~~ (1)(a) Permanently issued permits for
4 handicapped or disabled parking authorized by sections 18-1736 to
5 18-1741.07 issued prior to August 1, 2005, shall be valid for a
6 period ending on September 30 of the third year after the date of
7 issuance and shall expire on that date. Permanently issued permits
8 issued on or after August 1, 2005, and before January 1, 2008,
9 shall be valid for a period ending on the last day of the month of
10 the applicant's birthday in the third year after issuance and shall
11 expire on that day. Permanently issued permits issued on or after
12 January 1, 2008, shall be valid for a period ending on the last day
13 of the month of the applicant's birthday in the sixth year after
14 issuance and shall expire on that day except as otherwise provided
15 in subdivision (b) of this section.

16 (b) An applicant for original issuance or renewal of
17 a permanently issued permit issued on or after January 1, 2008,
18 may request that the department adjust the year of expiration
19 of such permit to match the reissuance date of the applicant's
20 handicapped or disabled person license plates issued pursuant to
21 section 60-3,113.

22 (2) All permits authorized under sections 18-1736 to
23 18-1741.07 for temporarily handicapped or disabled parking shall be
24 issued for a period ending not more than six months after the date
25 of issuance but may be renewed one time for a period not to exceed

1 six months. For the renewal period, there shall be submitted an
2 additional application with proof of a handicap or disability.
