A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Liquor Control Act; to amend
2 section 53-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
3 2006; to change provisions relating to attempted purchase
4 by a minor; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the
5 original section.

6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 53-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative
2 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:

3 53-101 Sections 53-101 to 53-1,122 and section 2 of this
4 act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Liquor Control
5 Act.

6 Sec. 2. (1) A licensee under the Nebraska Liquor Control
7 Act or his or her agent or employee who has probable cause to
8 believe that a person under twenty-one years of age is attempting
9 to purchase or has purchased alcoholic liquor may confiscate the
10 person's identification used in the attempted purchase or the
11 purchase of alcoholic liquor and shall turn the identification over
12 to the peace officer.

13 (2) A peace officer may arrest without warrant any person
14 under twenty-one years of age who the peace officer has probable
15 cause to believe is attempting to purchase or has purchased
16 alcoholic liquor.
