A BILL

1       FOR   AN    ACT   relating   to   the   Legislature;   to   create   the  
2                    State-Tribal Relations Committee.  
3       Be   it   enacted   by   the   people   of   the   State   of   Nebraska,

1           Section 1. The State-Tribal Relations Committee is hereby  
2 established as a special legislative committee with the intent of  
3 fostering better relationships between the state and the federally  
4 recognized Indian tribes within the state. The Executive Board of the  
5 Legislative Council shall appoint seven members of the Legislature  
6 from the membership of the following six standing committees:  
7 Education; General Affairs; Government, Military and Veterans  
8 Affairs; Health and Human Services; Judiciary; and Revenue. The  
9 chairperson and vice-chairperson of the State-Tribal Relations  
10 Committee shall also be designated by the executive board. All  
11 appointments shall be made within the first six days of the  
12 legislative session in odd-numbered years. Members shall serve  
13 two-year terms corresponding with legislative sessions and may be  
14 reappointed for consecutive terms. The committee shall meet as  
15 necessary to consider, study, monitor, and review legislation that  
16 impacts state-tribal relations issues and to present draft  
17 legislation and policy recommendations to the appropriate standing  
18 committee of the Legislature.
