A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicle registration; to amend section
2 60-301, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2006;
3 to change provisions relating to trailers; to harmonize
4 provisions; and to repeal the original section.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-301, Revised Statutes Cumulative
2 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:

3 60-301 Sections 60-301 to 60-3,220 and section 2 of
4 this act shall be known and may be cited as the Motor Vehicle
5 Registration Act.

6 Sec. 2. (1) Except as otherwise provided in the Motor
7 Vehicle Registration Act:

8 (a) A cabin trailer shall only be towed by a properly
9 registered:

10 (i) Passenger car;

11 (ii) Commercial motor vehicle or apportionable vehicle;

12 (iii) Farm truck;

13 (iv) Local truck;

14 (v) Recreational vehicle; or

15 (vi) Bus;

16 (b) A utility trailer shall only be towed by:

17 (i) A properly registered passenger car;

18 (ii) A properly registered commercial motor vehicle or
19 apportionable vehicle;

20 (iii) A properly registered farm truck;

21 (iv) A properly registered local truck;

22 (v) A properly registered recreational vehicle;

23 (vi) A properly registered motor vehicle which is engaged
24 in soil and water conservation pursuant to section 60-3,149;

25 (vii) A properly registered well-boring apparatus;

1 (viii) A dealer-plated vehicle;
 2 (ix) A personal-use dealer-plated vehicle; or
 3 (x) A properly registered bus;
 4 (c) A farm trailer shall only be towed by a properly
 5 registered:

6 (i) Passenger car;
 7 (ii) Commercial motor vehicle; or
 8 (iii) Farm truck;
 9 (d) A commercial trailer shall only be towed by:

10 (i) A properly registered motor vehicle which is engaged
 11 in soil and water conservation pursuant to section 60-3,149;

12 (ii) A properly registered local truck;
 13 (iii) A properly registered well-boring apparatus;
 14 (iv) A properly registered commercial motor vehicle or
 15 apportionable vehicle;

16 (v) A dealer-plated vehicle;
 17 (vi) A personal-use dealer-plated vehicle;
 18 (vii) A properly registered bus; or
 19 (viii) A properly registered farm truck;

20 (e) A fertilizer trailer shall only be towed by a
 21 properly registered:

22 (i) Passenger car;
 23 (ii) Commercial motor vehicle or apportionable vehicle;
 24 (iii) Farm truck; or
 25 (iv) Local truck;

- 1 (f) A pole and cable reel trailer shall only be towed by
2 a properly registered:
- 3 (i) Commercial motor vehicle or apportionable vehicle; or
4 (ii) Local truck;
- 5 (g) A dealer-plated trailer shall only be towed by:
- 6 (i) A dealer-plated vehicle;
7 (ii) A properly registered passenger car;
8 (iii) A properly registered commercial motor vehicle or
9 apportionable vehicle;
- 10 (iv) A properly registered farm truck; or
11 (v) A personal-use dealer-plated vehicle; and
- 12 (h) Trailers registered pursuant to section 60-3,198 as
13 part of an apportioned fleet shall only be towed by:
- 14 (i) A properly registered motor vehicle which is engaged
15 in soil and water conservation pursuant to section 60-3,149;
- 16 (ii) A properly registered local truck;
17 (iii) A properly registered well-boring apparatus;
18 (iv) A properly registered commercial motor vehicle or
19 apportionable vehicle;
- 20 (v) A dealer-plated vehicle;
21 (vi) A personal-use dealer-plated vehicle;
22 (vii) A properly registered bus; or
23 (viii) A properly registered farm truck.
- 24 (2) Nothing in this section shall be construed to
25 prohibit any motor vehicle or trailer from displaying dealer

1 license plates or In Transit stickers authorized by section 60-376.
