A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to notaries public; to amend section 64-210,
2 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2006; to change
3 provisions relating to the ink stamp seal; and to repeal
4 the original section.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 64-210, Revised Statutes Cumulative
2 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:

3 64-210 (1) Each notary public, before performing any
4 duties of his or her office, shall provide himself or herself with
5 an official ink stamp seal on which shall appear the words State
6 of Nebraska, General Notary or State of Nebraska, General Notarial,
7 ~~and his or her name as commissioned, and in addition, at his or~~
8 ~~her option,~~ the date of expiration of his or her commission. A
9 notary public may use the initial letters of his or her first name
10 and middle name. A notary public shall authenticate all his or her
11 official acts with such seal. Under his or her official signature,
12 on all certificates of authentication made by him or her, a notary
13 public shall write, stamp, or otherwise show the date when his or
14 her term of office as such notary public will expire if such date
15 of expiration is not engraved on the seal.

16 (2) A notary public shall authenticate all of his or her
17 official acts with such seal. The official seal of a notary public
18 shall be an ink stamp seal with which he or she shall authenticate
19 all of his or her official acts.

20 (3) A notary public whose commission was issued by the
21 Secretary of State before the effective date of this act is not
22 required to purchase a new ink stamp seal in order to comply
23 with this section until the notary public's commission expires.
24 Upon renewal, each notary public shall have engraved on his or
25 her official ink stamp seal all of the information required in

1 subsection (1) of this section.
