A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds
2 to develop and support drug abuse prevention and
3 education programs through the Nebraska Commission on Law
4 Enforcement and Criminal Justice.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$200,000 from
2 the General Fund for FY2007-08 and (2) \$200,000 from the General
3 Fund for FY2008-09 to the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement
4 and Criminal Justice, for Program 198, Central Administration, to
5 provide grants to develop and support drug abuse prevention and
6 education programs. The Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and
7 Criminal Justice shall award grants on a competitive basis to
8 cities, schools, or nonprofit organizations. All drug abuse and
9 prevention programs receiving money under this section shall focus
10 on elementary school-aged children and shall aim at preventing such
11 children from using illegal drugs.

12 There is included in the appropriation to this program
13 for FY2007-08 \$200,000 General Funds for state aid, which
14 shall only be used for such purpose. There is included in the
15 appropriation to this program for FY2008-09 \$200,000 General Funds
16 for state aid, which shall only be used for such purpose.

17 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and
18 per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated
19 in this section.
