1	Section 1. (1) Any employer who provides for compensated
2	leave and has policies governing non-compensated leave shall not
3	require an employee to use compensated leave when such employee has
4	legitimately qualified, by law or regulation, for non-compensated
5	leave, unless such employee requests to substitute compensated
6	leave.
7	(2) Any employer who violates this section shall be
8	subject to a civil penalty of not less than five hundred dollars
9	for each offense. All fines collected under this section shall be
10	remitted to the State Treasurer for distribution in accordance with
11	Article VII, section 5, of the Constitution of Nebraska.
