A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Hospital-Medical Liability

Act; to amend section 44-2828, Reissue Revised Statutes of

Nebraska; to change the statute of repose as prescribed; and

to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

LB 65

Section 1. Section 44-2828, Reissue Revised Statutes of

Nebraska, is amended to read:

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44-2828. Except as provided in section 25-213, any action to damages based on alleged malpractice or professional negligence or upon alleged breach of warranty in rendering or failing to render professional services shall be commenced within two years next after the alleged act or omission in rendering or failing to render professional services providing the basis for such action, except that if the cause of action is not discovered and could not be reasonably discovered within such two-year period, the action may be commenced within one year from the date of such discovery or from the date of discovery of facts which would reasonably lead to such discovery, whichever is earlier. In no event may any action be commenced to recover damages for malpractice or professional negligence or breach of warranty in rendering or failing to render professional services more than ten twenty years after the date of rendering or failing to render such professional service which provides the basis for the cause of action.

Sec. 2. Original section 44-2828, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
