Section 1. Section 25-1629.04 Reissue Revised Statutes of 1 Nebraska, is amended to read: 2 25-1629.04. After a proposed jury list has been selected, 3 4 the jury commissioner may require that each person listed on the 5 proposed jury list be served with a summons, issued by the jury 6 commissioner, to appear before the court at a time and place certain 7 for jury duty. The jury qualification questionnaire may be sent together with the summons in a single mailing to a prospective juror. summons may be served upon each juror by first-class, The certified, or registered mail, or by personal service by a jury 10 11 commissioner, the clerk, or other person authorized by the court. 12 After the initial appearance of the juror, he or she shall appear for jury service in any court of the county as directed by the judge of 13 14 any court during the term of jury service of the juror. 15 2.
