- FOR AN ACT relating to power districts; to amend section
  70-1014.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
  change special generation application provisions; and to
  repeal the original section.
- Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 70-1014.01, Reissue Revised Statutes

- 2 of Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 70-1014.01 An application by a municipality, a registered
- 4 group of municipalities, a public power district, a public power
- 5 and irrigation district, an electric cooperative, an electric
- 6 membership association, or any other governmental entity for
- 7 a facility that will generate not more than ten twenty-five
- 8 thousand kilowatts of electric energy at rated capacity and
- 9 will generate electricity using solar, wind, biomass, landfill
- 10 gas, methane gas, or hydropower generation technology or an
- 11 emerging generation technology, including, but not limited to,
- 12 fuel cells and micro-turbines, shall be deemed a special generation
- 13 application. Such application shall be approved by the board
- 14 if the board finds that (1) the application qualifies as a
- 15 special generation application, (2) the application will provide
- 16 public benefits sufficient to warrant approval of the application,
- 17 although it may not constitute the most economically feasible
- 18 generation option, and (3) the application under consideration
- 19 represents a separate and distinct project from any previous
- 20 special generation application the applicant may have filed.
