## A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to the Civil Air Patrol; to amend section

  S5-160, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to

  authorize military and emergency leave for public

  employees who are members of the patrol; and to repeal

  the original section.

1 Section 1. Section 55-160, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 55-160 (1) All employees, including elected officials of
- 4 the State of Nebraska, or any political subdivision thereof, who
- 5 are members of the National Guard, Army Reserve, Naval Reserve,
- 6 Marine Corps Reserve, Air Force Reserve, and Coast Guard Reserve,
- 7 or Civil Air Patrol, shall be entitled to a military leave of
- 8 absence from their respective duties, without loss of pay, when
- 9 employed with or without pay under the orders or authorization
- 10 of competent authority in the active service of the state or of
- 11 the United States or when performing a Civil Air Patrol mission.
- 12 Members who normally work or are normally scheduled to work one
- 13 hundred twenty hours or more in three consecutive weeks shall
- 14 receive a military leave of absence of one hundred twenty hours
- 15 each calendar year. Members who normally work or are normally
- 16 scheduled to work less than one hundred twenty hours in three
- 17 consecutive weeks shall receive a military leave of absence each
- 18 calendar year equal to the number of hours they normally work or
- 19 would normally be scheduled to work, whichever is greater, in three
- 20 consecutive weeks. Such military leave of absence may be taken in
- 21 hourly increments and shall be in addition to the regular annual
- 22 leave of the persons named in this section.
- 23 (2) When the Governor of this state declares that a state
- 24 of emergency exists and any of the persons named in this section
- 25 are ordered to active service of the state or Civil Air Patrol

1 duty, a state of emergency leave of absence will be granted until

- 2 such member is released from active service of the state or Civil
- 3 Air Patrol duty by competent authority. A military leave of absence
- 4 shall not be used during a state of emergency declared by the
- 5 Governor. Other forms of leave may be granted. During a state of
- 6 emergency leave of absence because of the call of the Governor, any
- 7 official or employee subject to this section shall receive his or
- 8 her normal salary or compensation minus the state active duty base
- 9 pay he or she receives in active service of the state. Governmental
- 10 officers serving a term of office shall receive their compensation
- 11 as provided by law.
