## A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to county government; to amend sections
  2 23-2502, 23-2536, and 23-2537, Reissue Revised Statutes
  3 of Nebraska, and section 23-2519, Revised Statutes
  4 Cumulative Supplement, 2006; to change provisions
  5 relating to unclassified service positions; to harmonize
  6 provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
- Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 23-2502, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 23-2502 As used in sections 23-2501 to 23-2516, unless
- 4 the context otherwise requires:
- 5 (1) Employees shall mean all county employees of the
- 6 county. The term employees shall not include part-time employees,
- 7 employees subject to the state personnel service, court-appointed
- 8 employees except bailiffs, employees of the county attorney's
- 9 office, employees of the public defender's office, dentists,
- 10 physicians, practicing attorneys, deputy sheriffs, officers
- 11 appointed by the Governor, or elected officers or the chief deputy
- 12 of each office or the deputy of each office if there is not more
- 13 than one deputy in the office;
- 14 (2) Part-time employee shall mean any person whose
- 15 position is seasonal or temporary as defined by the commission;
- 16 (3) Department head shall mean an officer holding an
- 17 elected office, an officer holding office by appointment of the
- 18 Governor, the chief deputy of any office or the deputy if there is
- 19 not more than one deputy, and such other persons holding positions
- 20 as are declared to be department heads by the county board; and
- 21 (4) Commission shall mean the Civil Service Commission.
- 22 Sec. 2. Section 23-2519, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 23 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:
- 24 23-2519 The county service shall be divided into the
- 25 classified service and the unclassified service. All officers

1 and positions of the county shall be in the classified service

- 2 unless specifically designated as being in the unclassified service
- 3 established by the County Civil Service Act. All county employees
- 4 who have permanent status under any other act prior to the passage
- 5 of the County Civil Service Act shall have status under the
- 6 act without further qualification. Positions in the unclassified
- 7 service shall not be governed by the act and shall include the
- 8 following:
- 9 (1) County officers elected by popular vote and persons
- 10 appointed to fill vacancies in such elective offices;
- 11 (2) The county personnel officer and the administrative
- 12 assistant to the board of county commissioners;
- 13 <del>(3)</del> Bailiffs;
- 14 (4) (3) Department heads and one principal assistant
- 15 or chief deputy for each county department. When more than one
- 16 principal assistant or chief deputy is mandated by law, all such
- 17 positions shall be in the unclassified service;
- 18 (5) (4) Members of boards and commissions appointed by
- 19 the board of county commissioners;
- 20 (6) Persons employed in a professional or scientific
- 21 capacity to make or conduct a temporary and special investigation
- 22 or examination on behalf of the board of county commissioners;
- 23 (7) (6) Attorneys;
- 24 (8) (7) Physicians;
- 25 (8) Employees of an emergency management

- 1 organization; and
- 2 (10) (9) Deputy sheriffs.
- 3 Nothing in the act shall be construed as precluding the
- 4 appointing authority from filling any positions in the unclassified
- 5 service in the manner in which positions in the classified service
- 6 are filled.
- 7 Sec. 3. Section 23-2536, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 8 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 9 23-2536 If a program is adopted pursuant to sections
- 10 23-2534 to 23-2544, the county service shall be divided into the
- 11 classified service and the unclassified service. All officials and
- 12 employees of the county shall be in the classified service unless
- 13 specifically designated as being in the unclassified service.
- 14 Positions in the unclassified service shall not be governed
- 15 by personnel rules and regulations adopted pursuant to sections
- 16 23-2534 to 23-2544. Unless otherwise designated by rules and
- 17 regulations adopted pursuant to sections 23-2534 to 23-2544, the
- 18 unclassified service shall include the following:
- 19 (1) Officials;
- 20 (2) The county personnel officer and the administrative
- 21 assistant to the county board;
- 22 <del>(3)</del> Bailiffs;
- 23 (4) (3) Department heads and one principal assistant or
- 24 deputy for each county department;
- 25 (4) Members of boards and commissions appointed by

- 1 the county board;
- 2 (6) Persons employed in a professional or scientific
- 3 capacity to make or conduct a temporary and special investigation
- 4 or examination on behalf of the county board;
- 5 (7) (6) Attorneys, including deputy county attorneys; and
- 6 (8) (7) Employees who are covered by the State Personnel
- 7 System.
- 8 Nothing in sections 23-2534 to 23-2544 shall be construed
- 9 as precluding the appointing authority from filling any positions
- 10 in the unclassified service in the manner in which positions in the
- 11 classified service are filled.
- 12 Sec. 4. Section 23-2537, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 13 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 14 23-2537 (1) A personnel policy board may be created
- 15 by resolution of the county board. The members of a personnel
- 16 policy board shall include one elected county official chosen
- 17 by the elected county officials other than the members of the
- 18 county board, one county board member chosen by the county board,
- 19 one member chosen by the employees who are not described in
- 20 subdivisions (1) through (8) (7) of section 23-2536, one lay member
- 21 chosen by the elected county officials, and one lay member chosen
- 22 by the county board. All members shall serve four-year terms,
- 23 except of the members first chosen, the elected county official
- 24 and the county board member shall serve one-year terms, the lay
- 25 member chosen by the county board shall serve a two-year term,

1 the lay member chosen by the elected county officials shall serve

- 2 a three-year term, and the member chosen by the employees shall
- 3 serve a four-year term. Each member of the board shall hold office
- 4 until his or her successor is appointed and qualified. Any person
- 5 appointed to fill a vacancy occurring prior to the expiration of a
- 6 term shall be appointed in the same manner for the remainder of the
- 7 term.
- 8 (2) A majority of the county board and elected county
- 9 officials may remove any member of the personnel policy board for
- 10 nonattendance at three meetings.
- 11 (3) A personnel policy board shall elect a chairperson
- 12 from among its members. A board shall meet at such time and place
- 13 as shall be specified by call of the chairperson or the county
- 14 personnel officer. At least one meeting shall be held quarterly.
- 15 Three members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of
- 16 business. Board members shall serve without compensation but shall
- 17 receive reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses.

- 19 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 23-2519, Revised
- 20 Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2006, are repealed.
