- 12 health care provider is engaged in the performance of his or her
- 13 official duties, with knowledge that the person against whom the
- 14 assault is committed is an emergency services provider or a health
- 15 care provider; or
- 16 (b) Recklessly causes bodily injury with a dangerous
- 17 instrument to an emergency services provider or a health care
- 18 provider while such emergency services provider or health care
- 19 provider is engaged in the performance of his or her official
- 20 <u>duties</u>.
- 21 (2) Assault on an emergency services provider or a health
- 22 care provider in the second degree is a Class III felony.
