1 Section 1. Section 60-6,268, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 60-6,268 (1) A person violating any provision of
- 4 subsection (1) of section 60-6,267 shall be guilty of an infraction
- 5 as defined in section 29-431 and shall be fined twenty-five dollars
- 6 for each violation. The failure to provide a child restraint system
- 7 for more than one child in the same vehicle at the same time, as
- 8 required in such subsection, shall not be treated as a separate
- 9 offense.
- 10 (2) Enforcement of subdivision (1)(b) and subsection (6)
- 11 of section 60-6,267 shall be accomplished only as a secondary
- 12 action when an operator of a motor vehicle has been cited or
- 13 charged with a violation or some other offense unless the violation
- 14 involves a person under the age of eighteen years riding in or on
- 15 any portion of the vehicle not designed or intended for the use of
- 16 passengers when the vehicle is in motion.
