- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to state administrative departments; to provide
- 2 a gender balance requirement for appointive boards,
- 3 commissions, committees, and councils of the state.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

LB 824

1	Section 1. All appointive boards, commissions,
2	committees, and councils of the state established by statute
3	shall be gender balanced except as otherwise provided by law.
4	No individual shall be appointed or reappointed to any board,
5	commission, committee, or council established by statute if that
6	appointment or reappointment would cause the number of members of
7	one gender to be greater than one-half plus one of the membership
8	if the board, commission, committee, or council is composed of an
9	odd number of members. If the board, commission, committee, or
10	council is composed of an even number of members, not more than
11	one-half of the membership shall be of one gender. If there are
12	multiple appointing authorities, they shall consult each other to
13	avoid a violation of this section. This section does not prohibit
14	an individual from completing a term being served on the effective
15	date of this act.
