A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to parole; to amend section 83-1,121, Reissue  
2 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions  
3 relating to revocation of parole; and to repeal the  
4 original section.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1                   Section 1. Section 83-1,121, Reissue Revised Statutes of  
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3                   83-1,121 A committed offender while on parole shall  
4 remain in the legal custody and control of the Board of Parole. The  
5 board may ~~at any time~~ revoke the parole of an offender or recommit  
6 him or her to the custody of the Department of Correctional  
7 Services, ~~with or without cause.~~ if, after a hearing, the board  
8 finds substantial evidence that the parolee has violated one or  
9 more conditions of his or her parole.

10                   Sec. 2. Original section 83-1,121, Reissue Revised  
11 Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
