A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to education; to amend section 79-862,
2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to clarify a reference
3 to reimbursement for expenses of the Professional Practices
4 Commission; and to repeal the original section.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 79-862 Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 79-862. The commission shall, with the advice and consent of
4 the Governor, appoint a clerk of the commission who shall hold office
5 at the pleasure of the commission. The clerk shall, under the
6 direction of the chairperson of the commission, keep a complete and
7 accurate record of the proceedings of the commission, record all
8 pleadings and other papers filed with the commission, issue all
9 necessary notices and writs, superintend the business of the
10 commission, and perform such other duties as the commission directs.
11 The clerk shall not be a member of the commission and shall not
12 participate in hearings before the commission except to schedule and
13 make other arrangements for the conduct of hearings.

14 The commission may also appoint or retain such other persons
15 as it may deem necessary for the performance of its functions and
16 shall prescribe their duties, fix their compensation, and provide for
17 reimbursement of their expenses as provided in sections 81-1174 ~~and~~
18 to 81-1177 within the amounts available in the budget of the
19 commission.
