A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Liquor Control Act; to amend  
2 section 53-169.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2007; to  
3 change provisions relating to a manufacturer's interest  
4 in a licensed wholesaler; to repeal the original section;  
5 and to declare an emergency.  
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1                   Section 1. Section 53-169.01, Revised Statutes  
2 Supplement, 2007, is amended to read:

3                   53-169.01 No manufacturer of alcoholic liquor holding a  
4 manufacturer's license under section 53-123.01 and no manufacturer  
5 of alcoholic liquor outside this state manufacturing alcoholic  
6 liquor, except beer, for distribution and sale within this  
7 state shall, directly or indirectly, as owner or part owner,  
8 or through a subsidiary or affiliate, or by any officer, director,  
9 or employee thereof, or by stock ownership, interlocking directors,  
10 trusteeship, loan, mortgage, or lien on any personal or real  
11 property, or as guarantor, endorser, or surety, be interested in  
12 the ownership, conduct, operation, or management of any alcoholic  
13 liquor wholesaler holding an alcoholic liquor wholesale license,  
14 except beer, under section 53-123.02, ~~unless such interest in~~  
15 ~~the licensed wholesaler was acquired or became effective prior to~~  
16 ~~January 1, 2007.~~

17                   No manufacturer of alcoholic liquor holding a  
18 manufacturer's license under section 53-123.01 and no manufacturer  
19 of alcoholic liquor outside this state manufacturing alcoholic  
20 liquor, except beer, for distribution and sale within this state  
21 shall be interested directly or indirectly, as lessor or lessee, as  
22 owner or part owner, or through a subsidiary or affiliate, or by  
23 any officer, director, or employee thereof, or by stock ownership,  
24 interlocking directors, or trusteeship in the premises upon which  
25 the place of business of an alcoholic liquor wholesaler holding

1 an alcoholic liquor wholesale license, except beer, under section  
2 53-123.02 is located, established, conducted, or operated in whole  
3 or in part unless such interest was acquired or became effective  
4 prior to April 17, 1947.

5           Sec. 2. Original section 53-169.01, Revised Statutes  
6 Supplement, 2007, is repealed.

7           Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect  
8 when passed and approved according to law.
