FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to amend sections 71-5714

and 71-7608, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2007; to change

the amount allocated to and use of the Tobacco Prevention

and Control Cash Fund; and to repeal the original

sections.

1 Section 1. Section 71-5714, Revised Statutes Supplement,

- 2 2007, is amended to read:
- 3 71-5714 The Tobacco Prevention and Control Cash
- 4 Fund is created. The fund shall be used for a comprehensive
- 5 statewide tobacco-related public health program administered by
- 6 the Department of Health and Human Services which includes, but
- 7 is not limited to (1) community programs to reduce tobacco use,
- 8 (2) chronic disease programs, (3) school programs, (4) statewide
- 9 programs, (5) enforcement, (6) counter marketing, (7) cessation
- 10 programs, (8) surveillance and evaluation, and (9) administration.
- 11 The money in the fund shall not be subject to any fiscal-year
- 12 limitation or lapse provision of unexpended balance at the end
- 13 of any such fiscal year or biennium. Any money in the Tobacco
- 14 Prevention and Control Cash Fund available for investment shall be
- 15 invested by the state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska
- 16 Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.
- 17 Sec. 2. Section 71-7608, Revised Statutes Supplement,
- 18 2007, is amended to read:
- 19 71-7608 The Nebraska Tobacco Settlement Trust Fund is
- 20 created. The fund shall include any settlement payments or other
- 21 revenue received by the State of Nebraska in connection with any
- 22 tobacco-related litigation to which the State of Nebraska is a
- 23 party. The Department of Health and Human Services shall remit such
- 24 revenue to the State Treasurer for credit to the fund, except that
- 25 of such revenue received on or after April 1, 2005, two million

1 five hundred thousand 2008, seven million dollars shall be credited

- 2 annually to the Tobacco Prevention and Control Cash Fund. Subject
- 3 to the terms and conditions of such litigation, money from the
- 4 Nebraska Tobacco Settlement Trust Fund shall be transferred to the
- 5 Nebraska Health Care Cash Fund as provided in section 71-7611.
- 6 Any money in the Nebraska Tobacco Settlement Trust Fund available
- 7 for investment shall be invested by the state investment officer
- 8 pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska
- 9 State Funds Investment Act.
- 10 Sec. 3. Original sections 71-5714 and 71-7608, Revised
- 11 Statutes Supplement, 2007, are repealed.
