A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Livestock Brand Act; to amend section
2 54-1,100, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
3 provisions relating to recorded brands; and to repeal the
4 original section.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 54-1,100, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 54-1,100 A recorded brand is the property of the person
4 causing such record to be made and is subject to sale, assignment,
5 transfer, devise, and descent as personal property. ~~Instruments~~
6 Any instrument of writing evidencing the sale, assignment, or
7 transfer of a recorded brand shall be ~~recorded by~~ effective upon
8 its recording with the Nebraska Brand Committee. No such instrument
9 shall be accepted for recording unless accompanied by (1) a written
10 consent to the sale, assignment, or transfer of the recorded brand
11 by the holder of any lien or security interest against livestock
12 owned or thereafter acquired by the owner of such brand or (2)
13 a written statement under oath by the owner of such brand that
14 no person has a lien or security interest against livestock owned
15 or thereafter acquired by the owner of such brand. The fee for
16 recording such an instrument shall be established by the brand
17 committee and shall not be more than thirty-five dollars. Such
18 ~~instruments~~ instrument shall give notice to all third persons of
19 the matter recorded in the ~~instruments~~ instrument and shall be
20 acknowledged by a notary public or any other officer qualified
21 under law to administer oaths.
