LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 390

Introduced by Judiciary Committee Ashford, 20, Chairperson;
Chambers, 11; Lathrop, 12; McDonald, 41; McGill, 26;
Pedersen, 39; Schimek, 27.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is to examine
firearm-related violence in Nebraska. The examination shall
include, but not be limited to, the following issues:

- (1) Firearm-related injuries and deaths;
- (2) Illegal firearm sales;
- (3) Illegal firearm trafficking;
- (4) The types of firearms used during the commission of
violent crimes;
- (5) Providing access to a person's mental health records,
if any, in order for such person to obtain a certificate pursuant
to sections 69-2401 to 69-2425;
- (6) Firearm safety;
- (7) Firearm training; and
- (8) Obstacles related to the sharing of information by
local, state, and federal agencies about violent offenses involving
firearms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE
HUNDREDTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:

1. That the Judiciary Committee of the Legislature shall
be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes

of this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
