

## Hundredth Legislature - Second Session - 2008 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 1051

Date of Hearing: February 11, 2008

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Nebraska law requires landowners to mow weeds and trim trees along public roads adjacent to their land. Mowing is required at least twice a year, before July 15 and sometime in August. This bill proposes to change the law so that the second mowing must be done before September 30, rather than sometime in August. Landowners are required by current law to trim trees along public roads at least once a year up from the ground eight feet. This bill proposes to change the tree trimming requirement to up from the ground at least fifteen feet.
