

## Hundredth Legislature - Second Session - 2008 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 1067

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 1067 changes provisions regarding reimbursements by political subdivisions for the costs of conducting their elections.

Currently, the reimbursement is based on a system that prorates costs based on the amount of ballot spaced used. Under the current process, it is possible for small subdivisions such as villages to be billed less than \$10 which is not reflective of actual costs. LB 1067 establishes a minimum charge of \$50.

The bill also amends an alternative "set fee" billing process for public power districts to require a \$50 minimum fee.
