

Hundredth Legislature - Second Session - 2008 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 1145

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The purpose of this bill is to extend four dates under the Petroleum Release Remedial Action Act from June 30, 2009 to June 30, 2012 to allow for additional reimbursement from the Petroleum Release Remedial Action Fund. This would apply to responsible parties, third-party claims and the Department of Environmental Quality for reimbursement for a remedial action it has undertaken under the Act.

Under current law, reimbursement is allowed only for claims for remedial action undertaken for releases that are reported prior to June 30, 2009.
