Introducer's Statement of Intent
LB 1163

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 1163 would require businesses providing tanning booth services to provide proper warning to customers about the dangers of tanning. LB 1163 would require a government mandated warning, noting the presence of ultraviolet radiation be displayed near each tanning booth in operation in the state.

LB 1163 would further require that consumers engaging in tanning sign a copy of the mandated warning acknowledging they have read it and know that they will be exposed to ultraviolet radiation while tanning.

LB 1163 also attaches penalties to those facilities not in compliance with these standards.
