

## Hundredth Legislature - First Session - 2007 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 248

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 248 relates to road improvement district elections (RIDs). This bill would streamline these elections and allow them to be conducted by mail. Current law requires that each time a RID is created it must be done by conducting a special election using a polling place and an election board of at least three members. It also requires that an initial board of trustees for the RID is elected at the same time.

LB 248 would allow the subsequent election of the board of trustees to be conducted by mail in odd numbered years and would allow the dissolution of the district if 50% of the property owners signed a petition. The petition would then be presented to the county board for action.
