

Hundredth Legislature - First Session - 2007 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 254

Date of Hearing: February 23, 2007

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 254 raises the age to which a child restraint system is mandated to eight years of age from the current six years of age. LB 254 also adds language to define "correctly installed *and used*" and language mandating *usage* of that correctly installed child restraint system.

LB 254 also allows a county or city attorney to dismiss any pending action against a person in violation of this section of statute if they provide evidence of attendance at a child passenger safety fitting station or checkup event or has a child passenger safety technician do an inspection of their child restraint system.
