

Hundredth Legislature - First Session - 2007 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 263

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The purpose of this bill is to allow for minor modifications to permits without having to publish a public notice or have a public hearing. Subsection 5 of the bill sets forth specific actions that are to be considered minor modifications which do not require public notice or public hearings. The intent of the bill is to allow for these minor modifications without notice or hearing because the modification either poses no risk or lessens the risk to the public health and welfare.
