

Hundredth Legislature - First Session - 2007 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 382

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 382 contains three elements:

- 1. A notary public's "commissioned" name shall appear on the official ink stamp seal for his or her use. The current option of using initials for the first and last name on the ink stamp is stricken.
- 2. The ink stamp seal shall show the date of the expiration of the term of the commission. The current option to have an ink stamp seal without the date of expiration of the commission is stricken.
- 3. Any notary public whose commission expires after the effective date of LB 382 may continue using his or her ink stamp that complies with the old law until his or her commission expires. Upon renewal, the ink stamp shall require the use of the "commissioned" name and the ink stamp seal shall show the date of expiration of the term of the commission.

This bill is one of a group of bills I have introduced on behalf of the Secretary of State.
