The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative Bill 433 eliminates the current presidential elector system in Nebraska in which one presidential elector is chosen from each congressional district and two presidential electors are chosen at large. With LB 433, the presidential candidate who receives the highest number of votes in the state will receive all five electoral votes.

LB 433, also, removes the requirement that each congressional district presidential elector must vote for the presidential candidate who received the highest number of votes in his or her district.
