

Hundredth Legislature - First Session - 2007 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 500

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 500 amends section 48-628 of the Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2006 to exclude apprenticeship training programs as a condition disqualifying an applicant for unemployment benefits. Additionally, LB 500 states that an employer's account shall not be charged for this type of training.

Such approved training includes, but is not limited to, apprenticeship programs established pursuant to section 3 302(c)(5) of the federal Labor-Management Relations Act, 29 U.S.C. 4 2842, as such section existed on January 1, 2007.
