The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 504 would prohibit hunting through the Internet. Hunting through the Internet is defined as hunting living wildlife in real time using Internet services to remotely control actual firearms and to remotely discharge live ammunition. This bill would also prohibit individuals from hosting hunting through the Internet or otherwise enabling another person to hunt through the Internet.
