

Hundredth Legislature - First Session - 2007 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 553

Chairperson: Brad Ashford Committee: Judiciary

Date of Hearing: February 22, 2007

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 553 proposes to do the following:

- 1. Repeal the administrative license revocation (ALR) provisions of law that apply when a driver submits to a chemical test and an illegal concentration of alcohol is detected (the ALR provisions tied to Nebraska's "implied consent" laws would remain);
- 2. Allow judges to deny bail when releasing an individual would constitute an immediate threat to public safety; and
- 3. Require judges to impound the operator's licenses of drivers charged with certain drunk driving violations.
