

Hundredth Legislature - First Session - 2007 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 590

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 590 is intended to allow school districts with an enrollment exceeding eight thousand five hundred students to form their own Educational Service Unite (ESU). LB 590 would also allow for the school districts to join either Omaha Public School (OPS) or Lincoln Public School's (LPS) educational service units with the approval of the Department of Education. LB 590 would also provide for the reorganization of a unit that a school district left. The ESU would need to reorganize with in a year of the new school district joining the ESU.
