Introducer's Statement of Intent
LB 621

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 621 seeks to enhance the penalty and enforcement provisions for speeding violations.

This legislation creates a new classification of speeding violation.

Under this new classification, the operation of a motor vehicle in excess of thirty-five miles per hour over the authorized speed limit will assess five points against the driving record of the operator.

Additionally, any person violating the maximum speed limit by operating a vehicle in excess of thirty-five miles per hour over the authorized limit, shall be fined four hundred dollars.
