The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 712 provides an exception to a state law that prohibits driving on the highways of the state with parking lights only turned on. The bill exempts motor vehicles equipped with daytime running lights designed by the manufacturer of the motor vehicle to operate automatically when the engine is running. Daytime running lights that are amber-colored are allowed under this bill if they were designed by the manufacturer of the motor vehicle to operate automatically when the engine is running.
