

Hundredth Legislature - Second Session - 2008 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 764

Chairperson: Brad Ashford Committee: Judiciary

Date of Hearing: February 13, 2008

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 764 adds the definitions of a bovine and equine to the statute 28-1008. A bovine means a cow, an ox, or a bison and and equine means a horse, pony, donkey, mule, hinny, or llama. It also adds that any person who intentionally trip or cause to fall, lasso or rope the legs of any equine by any means for the purpose of entertainment, sport, practice, or contest is guilty of a Class I misdemeanor. Another addition to the statute is that no person shall intentionally trip, cause to fall, or drag any bovine by its tail by any means for the purpose of entertainment, sport, practice, or contest is guilty of a Class I misdemeanor.
