The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The purpose of this bill is to eliminate obsolete language in the Nebraska Litter Reduction and Recycling Act that pertain to transfer of funds that have already occurred. The bill also eliminates duplicative reporting requirements concerning grant activities. Currently the Department of Environmental Quality is required to submit an annual report relating to the purpose of the Nebraska Litter Reduction and Recycling Act and to submit an additional annual report of funds credited to the Nebraska Litter Reduction and Recycling Fund in its LB 528 Annual Report. The LB 528 Annual Report provides all information concerning all department grant and program activities. The Annual Litter Report duplicates the information provided in the LB 528 Annual Report concerning the Litter Reduction and Recycling Grants program.
