The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 803 allows voters to register to vote and vote on election day.

Specifically, the bill allows voters to register and vote at statewide general elections at their polling place. Such voters will be required to vote by provisional ballot. To vote provisionally, the voter will certify to the following facts: the voter is a resident but not a registered voter of the county; the voter is registering to vote on election day for the first time since taking up residency in the county; the voter's current address is shown on the registration application; and the voter is eligible to vote and has not voted and will not vote except by this ballot.

The voter will sign the certification under penalty of election falsification.
