

Hundredth Legislature - First Session - 2007 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 83

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 83 changes provisions relating to Nebraska's Work Ethic Camp. LB 83 would expand the scope of offender participation at the Work Ethic Camp. Participation is currently limited to those sentenced to intensive supervision probation. LB 83 gives the Board of Parole discretion to place felony offenders in the Work Ethic Camp as a transitional phase prior to release on parole.
