

Hundredth Legislature - Second Session - 2008 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 860

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 860 removes the requirement for fingerprinting for the licensees under the Grain Dealer Act and the Grain Warehouse Act.

Currently, if an applicant is an individual, a chief executive officer president, or general manager, each applicant is subject to fingerprinting and a background check of his or her criminal history record information. The new language would only require the background criminal history information and strike the language requiring fingerprinting.
